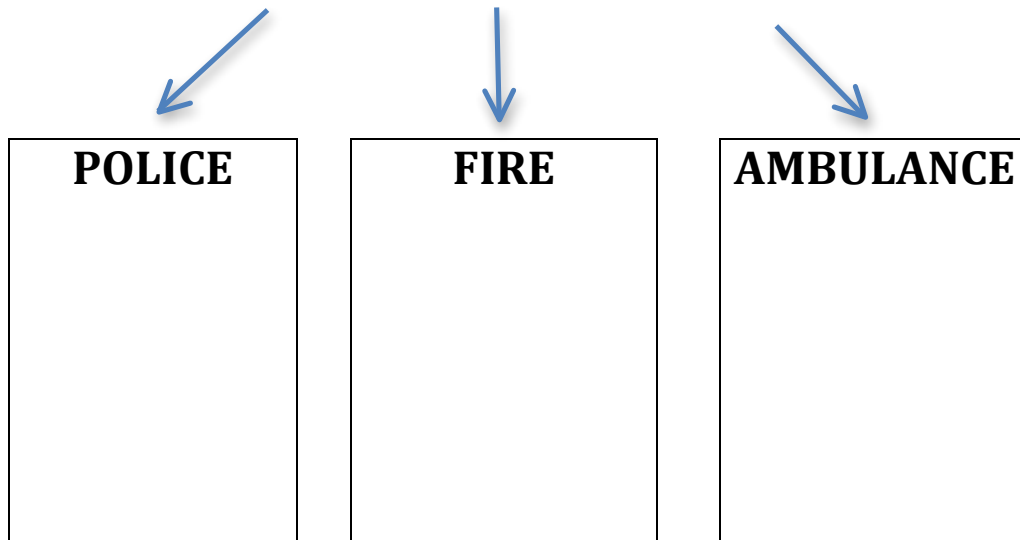


1.5 Emergency Medical Services

- Tell them what happened, what you have done, any paperwork, information, vitals, etc. you have taken, as well as the patient's _____ that have been gathered.
