









Signs and Symptoms

- Pain with or without movement
- Point Tenderness
- Deformity/ Cuts and Bruises
- Paralysis
- Loss of Bowel/Bladder control
- Priapism (Males only)
- Numbness and tingling

Treatment

Principle #1: Maintain ABC's.

Principle #2: Immobilize in position found

(roll to prone only if patient is not breathing. Maintain immobilization throughout)

The Guppy Breather

"C3, C4, C5 keep the diaphragm alive"

You must ventilate a conscious patient in this condition.
